To all Parents/Caregivers and Whānau,

You will be aware that we have moved to Level 2 of the Covid 19 alert system. For our school this means that we will:

- continue classes as normal, being aware of keeping social distance as much as we can;
- continue with safe hygiene practices - soap and hand sanitiser are readily available;
- continue with Year 7 camps - they are considered a bubble and all transport currently is on chartered vehicles and ferries meaning limited interaction with the public;
- continue preparations for possibly a more severe lockdown in the future;
- remain positive with our students about our current situation.

We ask that you support our school by:

- continuing to send your children as normal;
- ensuring that if your children travel on public transport (not the school buses) they wear a mask;
- keeping your child at home if they are unwell;
- picking your child up from school promptly if they become unwell at school;
- ensuring you sign if it you should come onto the school grounds;
- Please try not to come onto the school grounds unless necessary, for example: Dropping off and picking up your child at the school gate.

Just like you, we are unsure of what will happen next. We think it important to follow the advice given by the Government and the Ministry of Health. Should the situation change we will do our best to inform you of this as soon as we can.
