The School Council organised a group of 20 students to learn how to make a poi. This was to celebrate Māori Language week.











Science: Soil Biodiversity

On Tuesday this week, Room 8GS participated in some science education research for an Honours student and the University of Canterbury.

Hazel Fairweather, along with the Children's University, brought 15 microscopes into our classroom so that we could investigate soil biodiversity. We compared samples of soil invertebrates (tiny bugs) taken from Hagley Park and a native forest on the West Coast. It was fascinating to see what creepy crawlies are living beneath our feet. We saw springtails, mites, land shrimp, spiders, pseudoscorpions, worms and so much more.


We would love the PTA and Friends of PTA to come and support us for the Athletics day (Wednesday 16 October).
